Admissions Requirements

- A bachelor's degree (or equivalent) from a regionally accredited university
- A "principles of accounting" course in which the student earned a C or better or equivalent. William & Mary offers a free Financial Accounting Fundamentals tutorial. This tutorial offers a quick pathway for applicants without an accounting background to fulfill this requirement.  - One professional reference
 - One 300-word personal statement
 - Official academic transcripts from all institutions from which a bachelor's or graduate degree was earned

** Students who are required to complete the prerequisite courses can graduate in as few as 18 months.

*** There is no residency requirement for the Online MAcc program, but students have the option to participate in non-credit-bearing residency weekends.



Curriculum
