Admissions Requirements

- Completed [online application](#), including:
 - Official academic transcripts
 - Two letters of reference
 - [Personal essay](#)
- A bachelor's degree (or equivalent) from a regionally accredited university
- Current [resume or CV](#) with employment history
- At least two years of professional work experience OR prospects must otherwise demonstrate their business acumen
- Application fee of \$100 (nonrefundable)
 - The application fee may be waived for applications submitted by the priority deadline, active-duty military and veterans, W&M alumni, attendees of informational webinars, and at the discretion of the Admissions Office. Contact an admissions outreach advisor to discuss whether you qualify for a fee waiver
- Personal admission interview
 - Qualified applicants who have submitted and completed their application will be invited to schedule a personal admission interview. Interviews can be conducted via video conference or by telephone

*There will be no residency requirement for the Online MSF program, but students will have the option to participate in the Online MBA Residency.
